

# ROYALS SMOTHER M'GILL IN EXHIBITION ENCOUNTER

Big Four Team Leads After  
Initial Few Minutes  
of Game

## PLAYED IN DRIZZLE

Molson Stadium, Montreal, Sept. 23—(CP)—Montreal's Big Four Royals made their own "debut" here today to smother McGill Redmen of the Senior Intercollegiate Union 12-2 in an exhibition contest that opened the Montreal football season.

Rain, a ground, kept down to about 500 because of rain which fell for five hours preceding the game and only let up about half-way through the contest. The Royals scored a touchdown in the first quarter and added two more in the first section.

Besides three touchdowns, Royals added two points on converts and another two on singles. The Redmen, champions of the college league last year, opened the scoring with a single in the first quarter. The best they could do after that was another single in the second section.

A highlight of the contest was the great kicking of George MacFarquhar, who was booting the ball consistently 33 to 40 yards.

**First Quarter**  
It was still drizzling as McGill kicked off their start the game. In the first five minutes play resulted into a kicking duel, with neither team getting away long enough. The Royals' first play was a punt on the 25-yard line. Berrisford broke away for 25 yards after making a short kick from Dovey, and a moment later Foster kicked over the goal line for a point. McGill 1, Royals 0.

The McGill team kicked less than a minute, however. MacFarquhar kicked a punt on his 25-yard line, and MacFarquhar kicked the ball a short distance down the field, recovered it and passed for a touchdown. It was recovered by MacFarquhar. Royals 2, McGill 1.

Keefer supplied the only real action in the last five minutes of the quarter by breaking around the left end from his 25-yard line for 25 yards before he was forced over to the sideline and finally was trapped. For the rest of the game the Royals and McGill were in a kicking duel. First quarter over. Royals 2, McGill 1.

**Second Quarter**  
The first punt tried immediately after the break changed with no result. MacFarquhar kicked a 25-yarder to Murray. A moment later MacFarquhar kicked another to Berrisford for 25 yards. The second punt was by McGill in position for Foster to kick a single, with MacFarquhar being brought down. Royals 2, McGill 2.

McCullough kicked a beautiful 25-yard punt to MacFarquhar, but not by MacFarquhar on the McGill 25. Allen made a first down on two plays and then MacFarquhar got through on an end run to bring the ball to the five-yard line. On that down, Royals used a forward pass. MacFarquhar intercepted behind the McGill line.

Allen made 25 yards in a break through the middle of the Red line, bringing the ball to the McGill 25-yard line. The play that followed by the Royals but they were in position for a placement, about 25 yards out and directly in front of the posts. MacFarquhar kicked it and it went wide for a point. Royals 3, McGill 2.

Earl Smith intercepted a long "blower" pass kicked by McCullough and on the first play MacFarquhar kicked a 25-yard forward to McGill 25, setting McGill up inside of five yards. They failed to make the needed yard on second down and Foster kicked on the next play. The quarter ended a moment later. Second quarter over. Royals 3, McGill 2.

**Third Quarter**  
Jenkins kicked off for Royals and shortly afterward MacFarquhar kicked a 25-yarder to MacFarquhar. MacFarquhar kicked it out a few yards and Foster kicked on first down to his 25-yard line. Two yards at the line could be being made, and on that down, Foster tried a placement from 25 yards out, but the ball was low and fumbled against the charging McGill line.

A short while later Royals got their powerful ground attack going. MacFarquhar kicked a punt on the 25-yard line. On a third down, MacFarquhar kicked a punt to go Murray back a placement and the ball hit the 25-yard line. The first half was a point. Royals 3, McGill 2.

The last five minutes of the quarter found play changing with both sides at the end of the play, with the crowd getting its biggest thrills from the spectacular kicking of MacFarquhar. The halfly MacFarquhar was kicking well in and George MacFarquhar with the very best. The quarter over. Royals 3, McGill 2.
